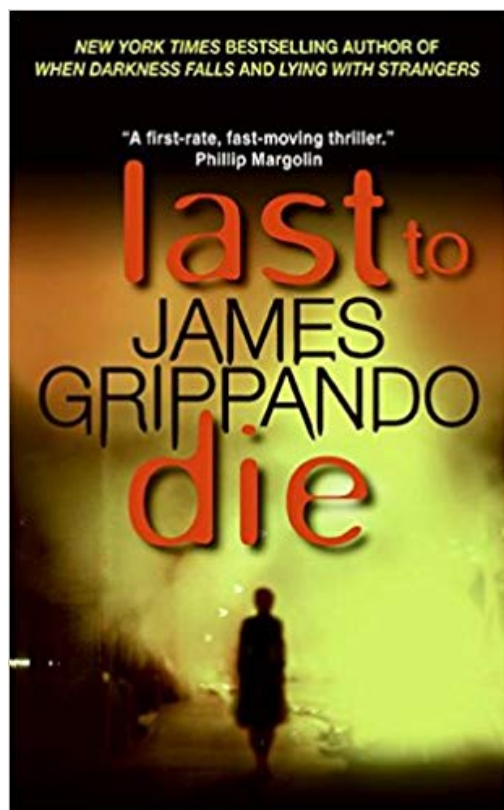

Beanisend

There are some authors with whom you can read and from the first moment you are in completely. They might have their inconsistencies and flaws but they have a writing style that you are able to consume without any real effort at all. For me, James did not start out that way. There will be things that bothered me, annoyances that I would have a hard time describing. For instance, Jack at first comes off a little too invested in the whole girlfriend thing, more than I think a guy might be, but then, that just could be my own flaws rattling the cage. This is the 6th book in the series and by now I'm completely absorbed.

James writes intelligent thrillers, with engaging characters and story lines. I think sometimes he does the flashback thing a little too much but it's usually in an effort to develop the story and the

characters. Some of you may not find that cumbersome. I felt like the first couple of books I had to push myself to get through at moments, but by 3 I was looking forward to the read. If you like stories about lawyers in dramatic situations, I think you will like Swytek and his protagonists.

Grippando is at his gritty best here. The plot has an extremely clever basis, with a bequest of \$46 million to go to the last survivor of six enemies of the deceased. But one of the legatees is a (former) hit man, who is presumed to be the murderer of the deceased. Well told. There are some diversions into current-day exploitation of child labor in current-day Africa, which while undoubtedly true, detract from the overall tenor of the book.
